BACKGROUND

Known to be the leading winery in the renaissance of Morocco's wine industry, the vineyards of Thalvin - Domaine Ouled Thaleb, are located in Zenata, the coastal region of Morocco. Enhanced by the warm rays of the Moroccan sun, the constitution of its soil, the use of sustainable farming methods and the handpicking of the grapes. The resulting traditional winemaking approach has led to the creation of the best of Moroccan wines, and provide a diverse range of wines, each created with a stylistic approach, unique blends and settled notes.

GRAPES

100% Sauvignon Blanc

VINEYARD

AOG Zenata Domaine Ouled Thaleb in Benslimane. The vineyard is situated on sandy shales and sand gravel soil. Vinified and bottled at the Domaine. All vineyards are ploughed and weeded by hand and no herbicide or fungicide treatments are used.

WINEMAKING

Low temperature fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

Green and bright gold color. On the nose, the wine shows vegetal notes, green bell peppers and jalapenos. On the palate the wine comes through with high acidity, nice texture and exotic fruits.

Between 50°F (10°C) and 54°F (12°C)
